**PRESERVING BRUNSWICK POINT
FOR AGRICULTURE AND MIGRATING
WATERFOWL HABITAT ACT**

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of British Columbia, enacts as follows:

Definition

- 1** In this Act:
“**Crown land**” has the same meaning as in the *Land Act*.

Preserving Brunswick Point lands

- 2** Brunswick Point Crown land, within the agricultural land reserve, which has
 - (a) a farm use covenant, restricting lands to agricultural use, and
 - (b) a conservation covenant, conserving the lands for soil-based agriculture and migratory bird habitat and resting grounds,in perpetuity, must be sold back to the original farm families or be offered to Delta farmers with long term leases.

Commencement

- 3** This Act comes into force on the date it receives Royal Assent.
